CONGRATULATIONS to Churchill and Weston Park who have completed site set-up and are now open to recruitment.

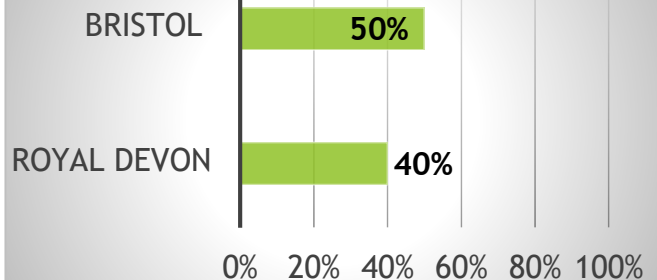
Currently, **9** out of the 11 sites are open to recruitment.

Updates & Reminders

- A new version of the Radiotherapy Guidelines (V1.3) have just been finalised by RTTQA and should have been sent out. If you have not received these please let us know.
- Substantial Amendment 3 is currently in progress and **Southampton** will be added as a new site to the APHRODITE trial as well as several changes to the central review process.
- APHRODITE's funder, Yorkshire Cancer Research (YCR), has recently changed to a new logo, which they describe as 'An exciting new chapter in our charity's history'.

APHRODITE site set up



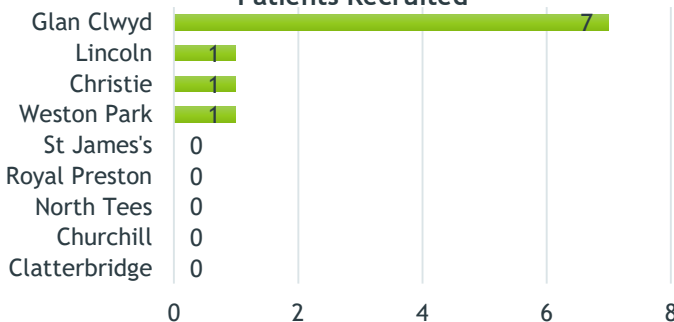
Data Management

As previously mentioned, the APHRODITE trial has now evolved so the majority of data collection is electronic. For those sites open to recruitment, we hope that you have been able to review the newly implemented Remote Data Entry (RDE) system for APHRODITE already.

RDE training materials should have been distributed to help explain in more detail the RDE process on MACRO. For sites that have not yet received their RDE training materials but would like to, please just email the Aphrodite@leeds.ac.uk inbox and these can be sent to you.

Access to MACRO is provided by the CTRU, and confidential login details will be sent to individuals via email.
