Recruitment

The trial has recruited <u>36</u> patients from across the 9 sites open to recruitment as of December 2022. Our ultimate target is to recruit **104** patients into the APHRODITE trial from across the 12 sites selected.

Congratulations to **Weston Park** for recruiting 2 patients so far in Q4 and to **Glan Clwyd** for reaching 15 patients recruited total! The table to the right lists the total number of patients recruited per site.

Site Setup & Randomisation

We continue to support setup at sites opening to the trial. Please note telephone randomisation will be removed from APHRODITE as this system is being closed in 2023. Please make sure to randomise patients via the online randomisation portal https://lictr.leeds.ac.uk/webrand/ in future.

CI Move and Non-Substantial Amendment 6

The CI Professor Simon Gollins has moved to a new position at Royal Shrewsbury Hospital from Glan Clwyd Hospital. To account for this, substantial amendment 6 has been submitted to REC and we hope to hear from them in the next 35 days. Additional minor amendment changes include removal of reference to Clavien Dindo (for post-operative assessment) and telephone randomisation



Discrete Choice Experiment (DCE)

The APHRODITE Patient Preference project is continuing to recruit participants, and we currently have 36 people who have completed the pre-treatment survey. We've also got six-month follow-up questionnaires from 14 participants already, and we're hoping to get more back soon. Recently we've started recruiting for Patient Preference study at Wrexham, and we're very glad to welcome them to the study as a participating centre.
