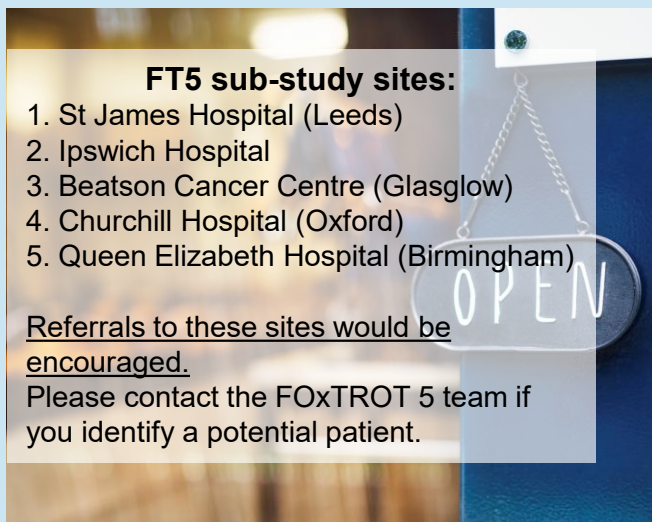


FOxTROT 4 - Celebrations

- ❖ We also want to thank all sites who have been diligently identifying patients. Please do not feel disheartened if patients who are being identified are not eligible, we understand there is only a small group of patients who will meet the eligibility criteria. Keep going!

FOxTROT 5 - Celebrations

- ✓ We are very excited to share that FOxTROT 5 has reached its recruitment target of 62 participants; 9 months before the planned end of recruitment!
- ✓ A massive ‘Thank You’ for all FOxTROT 5 sites who have worked so hard to identify and enrol patients so quickly!



Next for FOxTROT 5

- Sites to send all outstanding samples to central labs.
- Follow-up starts up to 5 years post-enrolment
- Sub-study to continue recruitment

FOxTROT 5 sub-study

Status: continuation of recruitment pending regulatory approvals

Recruitment will continue until November 2026 to reach the sample size of 20 participants for the sub-study.
